Event #4 – Hunt Stage Army Airfield - Ozark, AL - August 27-28, 2005

EVENT SITE:

Hunt Stage Army Airfield – Newton, AL
County Road 18, Newton, Alabama

Hunt AAF is a satellite field within the Army's helicopter training complex at Fort Rucker -- nicely aged, well-maintained airfield concrete, absolutely flat. The course takes up the entire ramp area and most of the center runway

Directions:

From Dothan, AL - Take Hwy 231 north out of Dothan. About 10 miles out of Dothan, cross over the Choctawhatchee River. Approximately 1.5 miles from the river will be a traffic signal. At the light, make a **left** onto County Road 18. Proceed on CR18 approximately 1 mile and Airfield will be on right.

From Montgomery, AL - Take Hwy 231 south out of Ozark. About 6 miles out of Ozark, pass by a rest area. Approximately 1 mile from the rest area, will be a traffic signal. At the light, make a **right** onto County Road 18. Proceed on CR18 approximately 1 mile and Airfield will be on right.
