Directions: Interstate 10 to exit number 351- toward WHITEHOUSE/CECIL FIELD. Turn LEFT onto CHAFFEE RD S/CR-115C. 0.2 miles, Turn LEFT onto W BEAVER ST/FL-10/US-90. 1.2 miles, Turn RIGHT onto HALSEMA RD N. 2.7 miles, HALSEMA RD N becomes FOREST TR RD. 0.4 miles, Airfield at the end of the Road.
